I look forward to seeing you in Lodge.

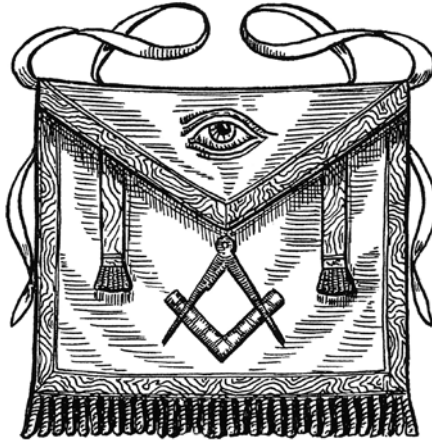
