of
ALEXANDRIA-WASHINGTON LODGE No. 22 Ancient, Free and Accepted Masons
Alexandria, Virginia Effective Date: TBD

Proposed Revised Version – 2017

ARTICLE I

The stated communications of this Lodge shall be held at the George Washington Masonic National Memorial, Alexandria, Virginia on the Second Thursday of each month, and on the 27th of December (the feast day of Saint John the Evangelist) for the purpose of installation of officers, at 7:30 p.m. o'clock.

The Lodge shall observe the birthday of Illustrious Brother George Washington with a Stated Communication to be held on February 22 of each year at a time of the Master's choosing. If the 22nd falls on a Sunday, this meeting shall be held on the following Monday.

The Stated Communication nearest April 28th, shall commemorate the anniversary of the date of the Lodge's original Virginia Charter, April 28, 1788.

ARTICLE II

Every member of this Lodge except Honorary Members and Life Members in Perpetuity shall be charged by the Secretary with the sum of one hundred and thirty-six dollars (\$136.00), plus the Grand Lodge dues and assessment as annual dues.

ARTICLE III

The fees for the degrees in this Lodge shall be five hundred dollars payable as follows: Two hundred dollars for the degree of Entered Apprentice, of which one hundred dollars shall accompany the petition; one hundred dollars for the degree of Fellowcraft; and two hundred dollars for the degree of Master Mason. The fee for affiliation for a Non-Virginia Mason shall be one hundred dollars which amount shall accompany the application for affiliation.

ARTICLE IV

The Treasurer shall receive an annual compensation of seven thousand five hundred dollars.

ARTICLE V

The Secretary shall receive an annual compensation of seven thousand five hundred dollars.

ARTICLE VI

The Tiler, shall receive an annual compensation of six hundred dollars.

ARTICLE VII

The five Trustees, who shall be elected by the Lodge, shall at each annual Stated Communication in December make a report of the investments of all funds and condition of property entrusted to their care.

ARTICLE VIII

Any amendment proposed to these by-laws must be submitted in writing at a Stated Communication, lie over the required four weeks, the membership be notified by the usual means, and shall require a two thirds affirmative vote of the members present at the next or a subsequent Stated Communication in order to be adopted.
