

# From the Secretary's Desk -

As we approach the end of the year, we raised 17 new members this year and had 6 members affiliate with our Lodge from other Lodges, resulting in an increase of 23 members. We have lost 12 members to deaths, 3 members to Demits and 7 members to Suspension for non-payment of dues, resulting in a loss of 22 members. We will finish the year with the gain of one member.

We have 160 members of the Lodge who pay dues. As of this writing 49 have paid their 2019 dues leaving a balance of 111 members who still owe their dues. The dues for the 2019 Masonic Year are \$191.00. This is because of the \$10.00 increase in the Grand Lodge Per-Capita assessment that goes into effect January 1, 2019. The dues are payable and due by January 1, 2019. **Once your dues are paid, you will receive your 2019 dues card in the mail.**

Federal Regulations do not allow you to pay dues with a company or business check. They must be paid with personal funds.
