

THE MASTER'S MESSAGE

Brethren:

I hope all of you are enjoying the last days of Summer as we rapidly prepare for Fall and all of the changes and opportunities it presents. We are able to enjoy the rare privilege of hosting the 2009 Prestonian Lecture at our Lodge. During our first Stated Communication of September, Right Worshipful Brother John Wade will present his paper "Go and do Thou Likewise: English Masonic Processions from the 18th to the 20th Centuries."

The Prestonian Lecture is the only Masonic lecture officially sanctioned by the United Grand Lodge of England. Named in honor of William Preston (1742 - 1818), the lecture is an accolade for Masonic researchers and historians. Only one individual is recognized with this honor each year for his excellence in Masonic scholarship.

In his paper, Right Worshipful Brother John Wade looks at Masonic processions, which were a regular occurrence in many parts of England from the first quarter of the 18th Century to the late 1930s. The paper asks why Freemasons no longer present themselves in public space as they once did and argues that Freemasonry should more proactively demonstrate their association with the community in the 21st Century.

Entered Apprentices, Fellowcrafts, petitioners, and guests are welcome to attend to hear RW Brother Wades' presentation. Dinner will follow the Communication and all are welcome to stay and enjoy the meal with us, however, I do ask that everyone who intends to eat dinner register with the Steward at reservations@aw22.com. To ensure we have an accurate count for food we need all reservations by not later than **September 4th**.

Because of the special nature of hosting RW Brother Wade, I have moved the monthly Lodge Business Meeting to the second Stated Communication on September 24th, which is also Warden's Night. Brother Andrew Hammer has put a great deal of thought and work into planning an excellent year for the Lodge in 2010 and I hope all of you come to hear about the activities he is scheduling.
