



Preliminary Treasurer's Report

began with a balance of \$804,239.32. In a stroke of luck, \$32,000 was withdrawn at the end of February when our account was at a high point for normal Lodge operations. A four percent withdrawal is made annually. Soon after, the impact of Wor. Bailey maintains detailed records of all Lodge financial transactions and they are available for review on request. He works closely with the Lodge Trustees and our fund advisors. Many thanks to the Trustees for their service and inthe COVID-19 pandemic on the market severely de-valued our accounts. Fortunately, we anticipate ending the year with more than what we started (as of this report \$822,126.29). Fingers crossed for continued strong markets.
