



WASHINGTON PEN KNIFE

A cherished piece of the Alexandria-Washington Lodge No. 22, AF&AM, collection is a simple penknife. Its closed length is 3 inches; its handle mother-ofpearl. The single blade is 13/4 inches long. The claim to fame of this otherwise nondescript cutlery antique is that it was in the possession of George Washington for 56 years after he received it as a gift from his mother. It was presented to AW22, where Washington served as the first Worshipful Master, by his nephew, Captain George Steptoe Washington, in 1812.
