


At the February Stated Communication I shared some of the Lodge minutes from 110 years ago. Notable, among other things, in those minutes was a visit from the Brethren of Liberty Lodge in Massachusetts. At the George Washington Birthday Stated we participated in Constitution Lodge of Beverly, England's, America Night. The fraternal links among our Lodges date to 1891. Bro. R.W. Padgett, a member of Constitution Lodge and a seagoing ship's captain, found himself detained in Boston awaiting freight. He and another detained captain, another Mason, learned that it was the day of the Masonic Lodge meeting in Beverly, Massachusetts. From that lodge visit, the initial bonds were formed. A Past Master of Liberty, Wor. Bro. Charles Woodberry extended the link to Alexandria-Washington Lodge, noting that Beverley, England, home of Constitution, was near George Washington's ancestral home at Sulgrave Manor.

Each of the Lodges' minutes note various references to fraternal Masonic links forged in the early 1890s. Visits between individual members increased and many gifts were exchanged between the lodges. More formal exchange visits commenced in 1972 and for the next four decades a three-year exchange visit took place. After a brief respite, 2019 marked the return to tradition and the rekindling of friendships among the three lodges. Next year, we are scheduled to visit Constitution Lodge and planning with both Liberty and Constitution will begin soon!

These relationships are endearing, but they require work. The Fraternal Relations Committee was revived in 2017 to ensure that AW22 reinvigorates old relationships and works on building more and greater bonds locally and around the world. The work of this committee needs assistance from the next generation of Masons. To keep our relationships strong, we must introduce each generation and assist them in exuding the fraternity we all hold dear.
