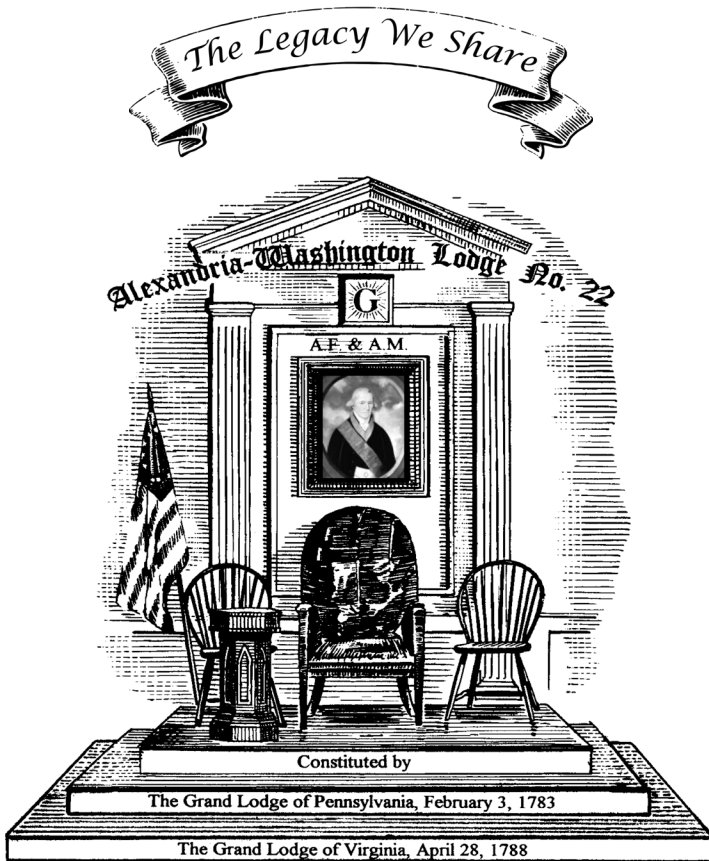

Dues notices have been mailed for everyone except international brothers, a few affiliates who have not been processed through Grand Lodge, and our two newest Master Masons. Dues for 2022 are \$225. The amount includes the \$55 Grand Lodge Assessment and your local Lodge dues of \$170. Dues are to be paid by January 1 each year. You may pay your dues online or mail a check or money order. If you are paying by cash, it needs to be in-person and exact change.

As a reminder, you get a lot for your dues. Recognition as an active Freemason in the Grand Lodge of Virginia, the Grand Lodge's quarterly Virginia Masonic Herald, monthly stated communications with interesting programs and the equivalence of a three-course meal, and Masonic support for yourself and family, if needed.
