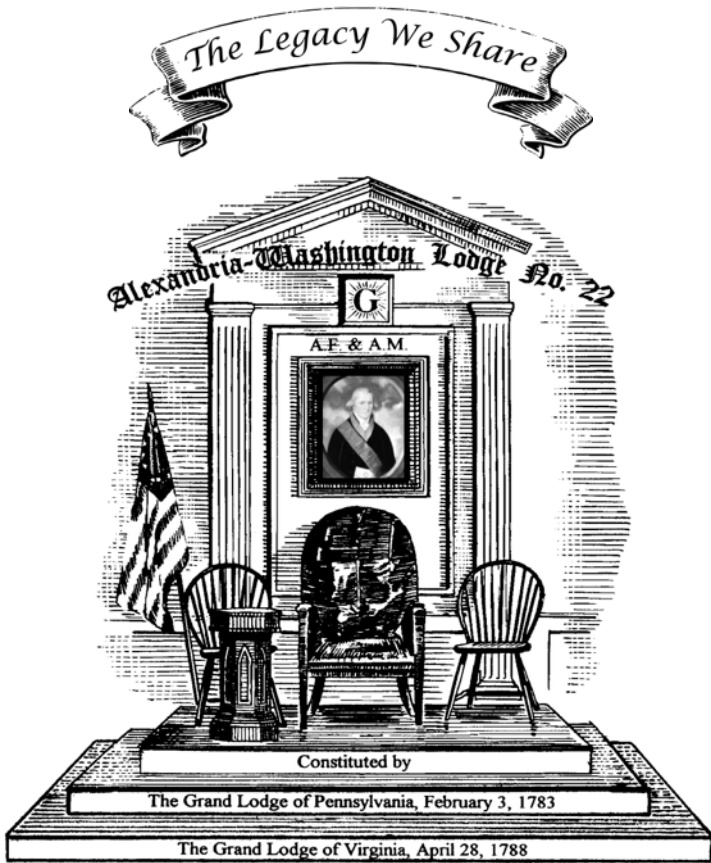

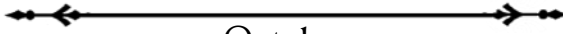

Challenge Coin Charity for Veterans



Old Dominion Chapter 364, National Sojourners is selling a challenge coin to raise money for Willing Warriors, a veterans charity located in Haymarket Virginia. Willing Warrior operates as a temporary “home-away-from-home” for recovering service members and their families. The special programs and services offered at the retreat are designed to inspire the warrior’s in the journey to rebuilding their lives. The Willing Warrior mission is to Provide cost-free retreat stays and programs that positively impact wounded, ill, and injured service members, disabled veterans, and their families. The average hospital stay for our recovering warriors is about 300 days. Following the healing of physical wounds, many of them are challenged with the “invisible wounds” of Post Traumatic Stress (PTS) and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) for a lifetime. The original small group of volunteers has grown into a coalition of individuals, small businesses, corporations, churches, and other organizations throughout Northern Virginia that help to provide the services that Willing Warriors offers

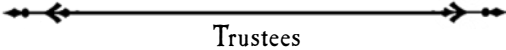

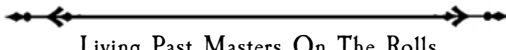
